Drawdown under \$100,000,000 Credit Agreement

On April 30, 2007, Cano Petroleum, Inc. (Cano) increased its aggregate borrowings under its currently existing \$100,000,000 Credit Agreement (the Credit Agreement) among Cano Petroleum, Inc., as borrower, and Union Bank of California, N.A. and Natixis, as lenders, to \$28 million. The interest rate on the amount borrowed fluctuates based on the LIBOR rate plus the applicable margin which ranges from 1.75% - 2.50% based on the utilization level. The interest rate on April 30, 2007 was 7.32%. No principal is due until November 29, 2009. The interest payment dates are May 8, 2007, May 16, 2007 and May 31, 2007. If the principal is not repaid on those dates, the term and the interest rate of the applicable borrowing may be modified with the term being up to 12 months from the aforementioned dates with interest payments being due at least every 90 days thereafter.
