Item 5. Other Information

On or about June 9, 2003, Applied DNA Sciences, Inc. ("the Company") made a repurchase of 7,500,000 shares of its common stock by partially exercising its option with Glenn Little, the former president of ProHealth Medical Technologies, Inc. Subsequent to the Company's reorganization in October of 2002, Glenn Little granted a one year option to the Company to purchase 8,500,000 common shares held in his name for \$100,000. For the Company's partial exercise, Glenn Little accepted a convertible promissory note in the amount of \$88,500. On June 30, 2003 the Company returned the shares to its stock transfer agent for cancellation. Glenn Little disclosed the transaction and his disposition of shares on a Form 4.

The number of shares issued and outstanding as a result of this transaction is 16,936,722.
