- (8) both performance-based conditions and time-based criteria. The performance-based conditions will be satisfied if certain targets for FY2014, determined by the Issuer, are met. The time-based vesting criteria are as follows: 1/4th of the units vest on the one year anniversary of the VCD and an additional 1/16th of the units will vest quarterly thereafter, subject to the Reporting Person's continued service to the Issuer. Both the performance-based conditions and time-based criteria must be met for vesting to occur.
